VMS, Inc. Awarded a Contract Extension and Renewal for Orange County Project

Orlando, Florida – VMS, Inc., an infrastructure asset management company, is proud to announce the extension and renewal of the Orlando-Orange County Expressway Authority (OOCEA) Asset Management Project. The five-year renewal adds an additional nine miles nearly doubling the size and value of the original contract.

“We are honored that the OOCEA has entrusted VMS to maintain their roadway and facilities for five additional years,” said Rich Herlich, President of VMS. “We have enjoyed working in the greater Orlando area and look forward to our continued relationship with the Authority.”
