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VMS, Inc. Awarded Contract for Nova Canal Maintenance

Melbourne, Florida – VMS, Inc., an infrastructure asset management company, today begins to fulfill its first-ever contractual duties for canal maintenance. Beginning October 18 VMS was responsible for cleaning and maintaining the 7.45 mile Nova Canal in Volusia County. The three-year performance based contract includes top-of-bank to top-of-bank maintenance including the water surface area and the connecting culverts. A connecting culvert is the structural drainage connection between segments of the canal. Connecting culverts may be pipes, concrete boxes, pipe arches or bridges.
